IF lack of support is something the Malaysian Sea Games contingent is worried about, then their fears would have been allayed in Putrajaya yesterday.

The Milo "Ole-Ole Malaysia Boleh" signature campaign saw two million Malaysians, including Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr. Mahathir Mohamad showing their support and this would have boosted morale ahead of Games which start on Saturday.

Jose Lopez, Nestle Malaysia's managing director, presented the two million signatures to Dr. Mahathir during yesterday's flag handing ceremony.

The campaign was launched in April and 20 Milo van covered the country to raise the signatures and Dr. Mahathir endorsed his support during the Tour de Langkawi appreciation lunch in May.

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
