JAMALUDIN ANNOUNCES BONUS PAYMENT FOR TNB STAFF

PORT DICKSON, Nov 1 (Bernama) -- Tenaga Nasional Berhad (TNB) Chairman Datuk Dr Jamaludin Jarjis today announced that the company would pay bonus to 25,000 staff for this year.

"We will discuss the issue at this month's board meeting," he said without elaborating on the matter.

Civil servants will be getting a half month bonus or a minimum of RM1,000 this year in addition to a 10 per cent salary hike next year.

This was announced by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir recently announced when he presented the National Budget 2002 in the Dewan Rakyat.

Speaking at a session for TNB staff with Negeri Sembilan Menteri Besar Tan Sri Mohamed Isa Abdul Samad here, Jamaludin also said that TNB planned to have its own complex in every state, full equipped with various facilities including living quarters for the staff.

"We have applied for land from state governments for the purpose," he said.

Jamaludin said TNB also had plans to set up a tuition centre in every district for children of the staff in appreciation of their services and contribution to the company.

"We will provide the teachers for these tuition centres," he said.

He said the company recorded RM2.1 billion profit this year.

Jamaludin said the company also did not forget its loyal customers by providing an incentive scheme to those who settle their bills on time.
