Khalid-Gathering

K3P TO HOLD SERIES OF GATHERINGS TO PROMOTE UNITY AMONG PEOPLE

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 26 (Bernama) -- The Listeners, Viewers and Readers Group (K3P) will launch a series of gatherings in all states from the end of next month, Deputy Information Minister Datuk Khalid Yunus said today.

He said the gatherings would promote unity among the people and enable them to get closer with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad who will be present.

"The gatherings are aimed at providing information on social development that brings about unity and counter propaganda spread by people with vested interests," he told reporters after chairing a national K3P Committee meeting.

It was important that people received correct information about the development carried out by the Government, said Khalid.

He said 3,000 to 5,000 people were expected to attend each of the gatherings to be held in all states, starting with the Federal Territory.

Khalid said that on the morning of the gathering, there will be "people's sports" events and expositions on past and future development projects carried out for the people.

In the afternoon, Dr Mahathir would give an address and then get to know the people present.

There will be a stage show at night where information and messages would be relayed through cultural event and performing arts.

Khalid said K3P planned to hold 69 meetings at the district level this year.

He added that the ministry was in the process of approving 100 applications to set up new K3P centres.
