KEADILAN NO LONGER RELEVANT TO PRESENT SITUATION, SAYS TAJOL

IPOH, Oct 16 (Bernama) -- The objective of establishing Parti Keadilan Nasional is no longer relevant to the present situation, Perak Menteri Besar Perak Datuk Seri Tajol Rosli Ghazali said today.

According to him, Keadilan was set up because its supporters did not agree with several actions of Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad but the people now supported the decisions of the prime minister.

"He (Dr Mahathir) is vocal in voicing his stand, including on the Afghanistan issue," he told reporters after launching the "Integrated Friendly Service" programme for enforcement agencies in Perak.

Tajol Rosli was asked to comment on a report in the "Utusan Malaysia" today which quoted Keadilan Youth vice-chief Hamdan Taha as saying that he had resigned from the post.

The report said Hamdan had also stepped down as Perak Keadilan deputy chairman and as the party's Teluk Intan division chief but would remain as a member of the party.

Last week, Keadilan deputy present Dr Chandra Muzaffar said he would not seek re-election to the post at party elections next month but would stay on as an ordinary member.

Asked if Perak Umno would persuade Hamdan to return to Umno, Tajol Rosli said it would prefer to leave it to Hamdan himself to make the decision.

Hamdan was previously Perak Umno information chief and Teluk Intan Umno Youth head.
