Keadilan: We will seek legal advice

KUALA LUMPUR, Tues. - Parti Keadilan Nasional will engage a lawyer to seek legal advice on measures to be taken against a report by an English daily which implied that the party's Shah Alam deputy division head Raja Kamaruddin Raja Abdul Wahid was a hitman.

Keadilan vice-president Mohd Azmin Ali said he had met party president Datin Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail immediately after reading the report to decide on the next course of action.

The report, among other things, said there was a plot to assassinate Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and his deputy Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi by certain groups and mentioned the name Raja Commando, the nickname of Raja Kamaruddin.

Azmin said although the party was not linked to the allegations, the report had implicated one of their party members.

"We do not want any quarter to smear the name of political parties or personalities. Although the report did not single out Keadilan, we have the responsibility to act on behalf of our member," he said.
