KHALIL VISITS AGONG IN HOSPITAL

SINGAPORE, Nov 1 (Bernama) -- The Yang di-Pertuan Agong, Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah is recovering well at the Mount Elizabeth Hospital here where he underwent surgery on Oct 6 to have a pacemaker implanted.

Information Minister Tan Sri Khalil Yaakob today visited the King who has been receiving well-wishers including Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and members of the Cabinet as well as his brother Rulers.

After Khalil's visit, the King left for a drive to Mount Faber where a cable car service to the resort island of Sentosa is located.

He was accompanied by Raja Permaisuri Agong, Tuanku Siti Aishah.

"Tuanku is making progress," said Istana Negara chief administrative officer Mohamed Yasin Mohamed Yunos.

Sultan Salahuddin has earlier thanked the people for praying for his recovery.
