Kindergartens donate RM1,000

KUALA LUMPUR, Sun. - Donations continue to pour in for the New Straits Times-initiated fund for the restoration of Universiti Malaya's Dewan Tunku Canselor which was destroyed in a fire on June 29.

Teachers, parents and pupils from Tadika Aladdin branches in Kelana Jaya and Damansara Jaya handed over RM1,000 to NST Sdn Bhd senior manager (administration and corporate organisation) Anselm De Rozario in a ceremony at Balai Berita here.

Principal, Reenna Ng, supervisor Koun Chai Nyok and six children represented the kindergarten.

Ng said the idea of collecting money for the fund was inspired by Prime Minister's Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohammad's donation.

"I realised that a lot of money was needed to help restore the building, hence the charity drive," she said.

For three months, the kindergartens distributed appeals for contributions to staff, the children and their parents.

"As a result, we managed to collect RM1,000, which I thought was a generous amount.

"Our main objective is to educate and train these children to `give and share while they are still at an early age'."
