KING IS STABLE, STILL IN CCU, SAYS GRAND CHAMBERLAIN

SINGAPORE, Oct 8 (Bernama) -- The Yang di-Pertuan Agong Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah, who successfully underwent a minor surgery at the Mount Elizabeth Hospital here last Saturday, is now in stable condition and recuperating in the cardiac care unit.

Istana Negara Grand Chamberlain Datuk Zubir Ali said here today that the King was still under observation and there was no reason for the people to worry.

"Doctors will again check his majesty's condition in the afternoon before transferring him to the ward," Zubir told Bernama.

The King was placed in the CCU immediately after the surgery for observation for 24 hours.

The Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad had visited his majesty at the cardiac care unit.
