Ling: We're confident of continued support

KOTA KINABALU, Fri. - MCA is confident Indera Kayangan electorate in Perlis will continue to support Barisan Nasional in the coming by-election as they want a stable Government and not one which was extreme.

MCA president Datuk Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik said the late Indera Kayangan assemblyman Datuk Khor Liang Tee had served the people well, giving confidence to the party to face the by-election.

The seat fell vacant following Khor's death last week.

"I think the people will not change (in their support). They have confidence in the BN to continue serving them through a stable Government stability and free of extremism," he said when asked to comment on latest developments of the campaign.

He said this at the old airport terminal in Tanjung Aru after spending two-days visiting various districts to identify a suitable site for the Abdul Rahman College branch campus in the State.

Dr Ling, who will lead the party's campaign for the by-election, also said he was confident that the Youth and Wanita movements would stand behind him in retaining the seat for the BN.

Dr Ling said the candidate would be decided by BN chairman and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.
