MAHATHIR MEETS NATIONAL UNITY ADVISORY PANEL

PUTRAJAYA, Feb 15 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister, Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today met a 43-member delegation from the National Unity Advisory Panel.

The panel, formed in 1974, is a body that functions to discuss unity issues, forges positive relationship between races and prevents conflict which can spark disharmony and confrontation between races.

The meeting was held at the Perdana Conference room of the Prime Minister's Department here at 3.40pm.

The delegation was led by National Unity and Community Development Minister Datuk Dr Siti Zaharah Sulaiman, who is also the chairman of the panel.

The 48 members of the panel are appointed by the Prime Minister.
