MALAYSIA WILL FIGHT TERRORIST GROUP REGARDLESS OF RELIGION, RACE

SINGAPORE, Nov 10 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi said the Malaysian government would remain firm in fighting terrorism and would act against militant groups without discrimination.

"We will act against any militant group irrespective of religion and race," he told Malaysian reporters after leading the contingent from the Ministry of Home Affairs for the friendly games with the Singapore Home Ministry, here today.

Abdullah, who is also Home Minister, had also called on Singapore Prime Minister Goh Chok Tong.

"Prime Minister Goh wants to know the latest developments in Malaysia especially the activities of KMM and the announcement by the Prime Minister (Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad) that Malaysia is an Islamic state.

"I told him what it is all about, he said he understood and believes that Malaysia under the leadership of Dr Mahathir and Barisan Nasional would be moderate."

Goh had joined Abdullah and Singapore Home Affairs Minister Wong Kan Seng for a round of golf at the Tanah Merah Country Club this morning.

Abdullah also called on Singapore Deputy Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong who gave him a brief on the economic situation of the island-state which is in a recession.

Lee said Singapore's economy was very much dependent on the economic situation of neighbouring countries although it had strong trade links with the United States, Abdullah added.

On the friendly games between the home ministries of the two countries, Abdullah said they could foster closer relations between the officers and the agencies of the two neighbouring countries.

Much cooperation could be forged between the police, immigration and anti-narcotic agencies of the two countries, he added.

Also in the Malaysian team were Home Ministry Secretary-General Datuk Seri Aseh Che Mat, Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Norian Mai and senior ministry officials.
