MCA LEADERS TO MEET ON SATURDAY TO DISCUSS INDERA KAYANGAN BY-ELECTION

KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 31 (Bernama) -- MCA president Datuk Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik said today all the MCA leaders will meet on Jan 5 to discuss the campaign plan for the Indera Kayangan by-election.

"We will campaign as one MCA team for the Barisan Nasional (BN). Nobody will be left out," he said when contacted here.

He said the meeting would be held at the Indera Kayangan Barisan Nasional Ops Room.

He, however, did not say who would attend the meeting

Dr Ling, who is Transport Minister, earlier met Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad at his office in Putrajaya.

He said he and Dr Mahathir discussed arrangements for the by-election.

They had broad discussion on the BN candidate and he submitted the names of potential candidates to Dr Mahathir.

"Now it is up to prime minister to decide," he said.

The Indera Kayangan seat fell vacant following the death of its assemblyman, Datuk Khor Liang Tee, on Dec 19. The by-election date has yet to be fixed.
