Moderate leadership key to success

THE moderate leadership of the Barisan Nasional under Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad is the main reason the coalition has continued to govern the country.

Parti Bansa Dayak Sarawak president Datuk Leo Moggie said the BN would continue to be relevant in ensuring a peaceful and harmonious Malaysia.

The PBDS leader said "we do not want Malaysia to be under (the leadership of) certain people who seem to only favour certain races".

Moggie also supported Dr Mahathir's tribute to the nation's past and serving leaders without whose wisdom Malaysia would not be what it is today.
