Moggie sure BN will sweep all seats with its record

SEREMBAN, Tues. - Parti Bansa Dayak Sarawak president Datuk Amar Leo Moggie said he was confident that the Barisan Nasional would win all the 62 State seats contested in the coming polls.

"We have good a track record and the people can testify to all the good works that have been implemented for them. Furthermore, the relationship among the BN component parties in Sarawak is very close."

Moggie, who is Energy, Communications and Multimedia Minister, said this after closing a two-day workshop on industrial contents at a hotel here today.

He said the opposition in Sarawak did not have a platform nor common stand that could give voters the confidence.

"I am confident we can attract the masses to vote for the BN with confidence." Moggie assured that the BN would continue to do their best for the people.

On intensive campaigns by the oppositions in Sarawak, he said the voters knew what the opposition was up to.

Moggie also said the PBDS had nominated its candidates and submitted the list to State BN chairman and Chief Minister Tan Sri Abdul Taib Mahmud.

"I gather he has met Prime Minister (Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad) on the candidates. Taib will make the announcement (on the candidates) a few days before nomination day. However, we have a rough idea who the candidates are."

He said some parties might have more changes than other parties.
