Moroccan PM to visit KL for talks with Dr Mahathir

KUALA LUMPUR, Sat. - Moroccan Prime Minister Abderrahman Youssoufi will arrive here on Monday for a four-day visit.

A Wisma Putra statement today said Abderrahman is scheduled to meet his Malaysian counterpart Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to discuss ways of enhancing bilateral relations.

A memorandum of understanding between the Multimedia Development Corporation and the Moroccan Information TechnoPark Company is expected to be signed during the visit.

Abderrahman will be accompanied by his wife, Helene, and a 36-member delegation comprising government officials and businessmen.

The Moroccan leader and his spouse will also have an audience with the Acting Yang di-Pertuan Agong Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin and Permaisuri Nur Zahirah.
