National Youth Day Assembly in Ipoh on May 15

KUALA LUMPUR, Sun. - The Youth and Sports Ministry will be organising the National Youth Day Assembly 2001 in conjunction with World Youth Day celebrations.

The assembly on May 15 at Stadium Perak in Ipoh is aimed at emphasising the participation of the society and youths in activities involving knowledge, community service, sports and volunteerism.

It is expected to attract about 3,000 youth and society leaders from various levels nationwide.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will open the assembly.

With the theme, Volunteerism as a Catalyst to Unity, it is hoped to be effective in building a stable society and to inculcate the spirit of self-help, care and the willingness to sacrifice.

The assembly is jointly organised by the Malaysian Youth Council and Perak State Government.

Among the programmes scheduled are Malaysia International Youth Festival, Volunteerism and Youth Convention, Exhibition and Information on Youth Organisation and Youth Run 2001.
