NIK AZIZ LEAVES IT TO THE WISDOM OF THE CHINESE

KOTA BAHARU, March 29 (Bernama) -- Kelantan Menteri Besar Datuk Nik Abdul Aziz Nik Mat said today he leaves it to the wisdom of the Chinese if they want to support PAS.

He said the Chinese are smart in politics.

"...if you want to give them advice, go ahead," he said when commenting on Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's advice to the Chinese yesterday not to fall prey to the ploy by PAS which seemed to be championing issues involving the community.

Nik Aziz said the advice to the Chinese showed that Umno feared PAS.

"Certainly does, or else why make such a statement?...really desperate," he said.

Nik Aziz also regretted that certain people had played up his visit to Bukit Pelandok, Negeri Sembilan as wanting to resolve the problem of the pig farmers in the area.

He said he was invited there to open a PAS branch office.

"I was then invited to see the situation and saw an abandoned site," he said.

He said a representative of the pig farmers then asked him to help resolve their problems since through his presence at the meeting of Mentris Besar and Chief Ministers.

The issue could not be resolved because Kelantan Menteri Besar was not invited to the meeting, said State Unity, Tourism, Culture and Non-Governmental Organisation Committee Chairman Anuar Tan Abdullah.
