"KELANTAN PEOPLE'S ACTION COUNCIL" CALLS FOR WORLD PEACE

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 28 (Bernama) -- The "Kelantan People's Action Council" today handed over a letter to the United States Embassy here in which it called for world peace.

The letter was handed over to the embassy's First Secretary W.Gary Gray by the council president Datuk Ibrahim Ali.

"The note is addressed to President George W.Bush and stresses the importance of global peace. We don't want the US to use military retaliation against Afghanistan or any other nation," Ibrahim, who was accompanied by 15 members of the council's executive committee, told reporters later.

The note also condemned any action that would jeopardise civil liberty and any attempt to link terrorism with Islam.

Ibrahim said the Kelantan Council supported Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's call to the United Nations to organise a world conference on terrorism "so that we can define terrorists because not all terrorists are Muslims."
