PAS SHOULD RESPOND TO CHALLENGE, SAYS MUHYIDDIN

KUALA LUMPUR, June 21 (Bernama) -- PAS, which has misled the Malays, should respond to the challenge issued by Umno president and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, said Umno vice president Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin.

"The Malays have been misled by PAS to the extent that they conveniently forget the lessons of history and disregard government policies," he said.

Dr Mahathir Mohamad, in addressing the 55th Umno general assembly, had challenged PAS to put in writing the type of "non-infidel and non-secular" government it wished to set up in Malaysia.

Muhyiddin also said Dr Mahathir's speech at the general assembly needed to be looked at in its full context to get its real meaning.

Umno Supreme Council member Datuk Ahmad Zahid Hamidi said the PAS actions had also caused a mental block among the Malays.

"So, PAS must respond to this challenge," he said.

Pahang Umno chairman Datuk Seri Adnan Yaakob, meanwhile, called on opposition parties to cease spreading lies and to cause a split among the Malays.
