Paskal to give display of skills on water

PASUKAN Khas Laut (Paskal), the Royal Malaysian Navy elite commandos, will be conducting a series of demonstrations during Lima '01 showcasing their expertise in conducting specialised seaborne operations.

Paskal, modelled after the British elite Special Boat Service, will give a display of its skills with the rigid-patrol boats and underwater insertion.

The boats are used to land elite in raids.

The Royal Malaysian Navy will also demonstrate the latest addition to its fleet, the fast troop vessel, Seri Tiga during Lima 01.

Meanwhile, some 20 RMN ships have joined 10 other naval vessels from more than five countries for a Fleet Review to be conducted by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

They are berthed off the Star Cruises jetty near Porto Malai where the maritime segment of Lima '01 is held.

Among the ships involved are frigates KD Jebat and KD Lekiu, Italian Navy ship ITS San Giorgio and Singapore Navy's RSS Endeavour.
