PM VISITS AGONG IN SINGAPORE AGAIN

SINGAPORE, Oct 18 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today again visited Yang di-Pertuan Agong Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah, who is recuperating after a minor surgery at Mount Elizabeth Hospital here.

Dr Mahathir, accompanied by Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali, spent about 20 minutes with His Majesty and also met members of the medical team, who is supervising his recovery.

This is the fourth time Dr Mahathir is visiting the King.

The hospital's consultant cardiologist Datuk Dr Richard Ng said Sultan Salahuddin is recovering well.

"His condition is good. He is recovering well," said Dr Ng.

The King, who spoke to Malaysian reporters on Monday and thanked the people for their prayers for his recovery, continues to receive visitors.

His grandson Tengku Syed Budriz Jamallulail said Sarawak's Yang di-Pertua Negeri Tun Abang Muhammad Salahuddin and his wife, Toh Puan Hajah Nokiah also visited the King this morning.
