PM MEETS KELANTAN BN LEADERS

KOTA BAHARU, April 20 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, who is Barisan Nasional (BN) chairman, met leaders of the Kelantan BN component parties this afternoon in conjunction with his one-day visit to the state.

The closed-door meeting at the residence of former Kelantan Menteri Besar Tan Sri Mohamed Yaakob in Taman Uda Murni here lasted for 45 minutes.

Present at the meeting were Kelantan Umno liaison chief Datuk Mustapa Mohamed, Kelantan MCA deputy chairman Liong Su Siang and Kelantan MIC chairman M. Kupusamy.

Dr Mahathir, who is Umno president, earlier had lunch there with the Taman Uda Murni mosque committee members, Kelantan Umno veterans and leaders of the Kelantan Cuepacs and non-governmental organisations (NGOs).

Earlier, Dr Mahathir performed Friday prayers at the Taman Uda Murni mosque where he was greeted by the people from its vicinity.
