PWTC'S INTERNAL ELECTRICAL SYSTEM NOT WITHIN TNB'S JURISDICTION

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 6 (Bernama) -- Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB) said today its electricity supply to the Putra World Trade Centre (PWTC) here was normal even though some parts of PWTC experienced supply disruption yesterday.

In a statement issued here, it said that the PWTC building management team had the jurisdiction over the operations and maintenance of the internal electrical system of PWTC.

"As a general information, TNB confirmed that there was a partial supply disruption to some parts of PWTC yesterday at 5.30pm.

"We are pleased to note that the supply to the affected building was normalised at 7.10pm by the PWTC building management team who has the jurisdiction over the operations and maintenance of the internal electrical system of PWTC," it said in response to newspaper reports on the electricity supply disruption.

TNB said its personnel were available to assist the PWTC during the period.

It was reported today that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, who chaired a Barisan Nasional Supreme Council meeting, took the option of walking down 35 floors when the power disruption caused lifts to stop working.
