Rolls Royce road show

CAN you imagine the sight of 90 Rolls Royce and Bentley cars driving around Malaysia?

That's just what will take place from October 25 when about 200 participants from the Rolls Royce Enthusiasts' Club, (an association for Rolls Royce and Bentley car owners from the UK) start their 18-day Tour of Malaysia.

The tour, organised for the second time by the club - the first was to the Middle East, is aimed at promoting tourism in Malaysia as well as in providing its members with new ground to drive on.

We're not just looking at Rolls Royce and Bentleys of the nineties, but cars that date back to the early twenties and thirties, all maintained in mint condition.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will flag off the tour at Putrajaya on October 27, and the convoy's first stop will be at Sepang International Circuit before proceeding on a tour of Kuala Lumpur.

The cars will then make their way to Malacca before back tracking North towards Cameron Highlands. The tour will stop in Penang, Kuala Kangsar, Lumut and Pulau Pangkor before ending in Kuala Lumpur.
