Rotation of CM's post: I'm still thinking, says PM

KOTA KINABALU, Sun. - Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad said he was still thinking whether or not to continue rotating the Chief Minister's post in Sabah.

"I haven't made up my mind. I am talking and talking," he told a Press conference during his one-hour stop-over en route to Kuala Lumpur from an official visit to Osaka in Japan.

During the stop-over, Dr Mahathir met with the Sabah State Cabinet led by Chief Minister Datuk Seri Osu Sukam.

Asked if a non-Muslim Bumiputera would be appointed to the post after the term of current Chief Minister ends in March, he said: "If I reveal everything, then there is no need to talk."

When pressed further whether the rotation would be continued, he said: "As of now, it is still under implementation."

The system to rotate the Chief Minister's post was introduced soon after Barisan Nasional took over the State administration in April 1994.
