Sea Games torch passes through Klang Valley

THE TORCH RUNS ON ... The torch for the 21st SEA Games in Kuala Lumpur beginning on Sept 7 passed through the Klang Valley yesterday.

The run began in Labuan on March 10 and has been paraded in all nooks and corners of the country covering a distance of 7,884km.

The last leg of the run will see the handing over of the torch to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad at Dataran Merdeka.

It will end at the Bukit Jalil National Stadium on Sept 8.

About 4,000 people, including former national and state athletes, have participated in the run, which passed through 24 villages.

From Labuan, it went to Sabah and Sarawak. In the peninsula, it started in Langkawi and passed through Perlis, Kedah, Penang, Perak, Kelantan, Terengganu, Pahang, Johor, Malacca, Negri Sembilan, Selangor and Kuala Lumpur.
