SELANGOR UMNO CONVENTION SEEKS TO STRENGTHEN PARTY IN FACING POLLS

SHAH ALAM, May 2 (Bernama) -- Selangor Umno is organising a series of events beginning this Saturday aimed at strengthening the party to face the next general election, said State Umno chief Tan Sri Muhammad Muhammad Taib.

The events would culminate in the Selangor Umno Convention on June 16 and 17, he said.

"We want to give the opportunity to as many people as possible to give ideas on enhancing the party in facing the next general election," he told a press conference here today.

Also present were convention organising committee chairman Datuk Salamon Selamat, Selangor Umno secretary Datuk Raja Ideris Raja Ahmad and State Umno information chief Datuk Abdul Rahman Palil.

Muhammad, who is an Umno vice-president, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad would open the convention on June 16 while Selangor Menteri Besar Selangor Datuk Seri Dr Mohd Khir Toyo would close it the following day.

Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi is expected to attend a dinner in conjunction with the convention on June 16.

The pre-convention events would kick off this Saturday with a keynote address by Mohd Khir at Hotel Bluewave here.
