ST LUCIA PRIME MINISTER TO VISIT MALAYSIA

KUALA LUMPUR, May 4 (Bernama) -- St Lucia Prime Minister Dr Kenny D.Anthony will make a four-day visit to Malaysia beginning next Wednesday, the Foreign Ministry said today.

This will be the first visit to Malaysia by the prime minister of the small Caribbean island state and is aimed at strengthening bilateral relations, the ministry said in a statement today.

During his stay, Dr Anthony is scheduled to have a meeeting with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and visit Langkawi and the Multimedia University in Cyberjaya.

Dr Anthony will be accompanied by his wife Rose Marie Anthony and four officials.

St Lucia, which has a population of 147,000, gained independence in 1979 and is a member of the Commonwealth.
