Steady stream of visitors for the King at hospital

KUALA LUMPUR, Mon. - The Yang di-Pertuan Agong Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah, who is continuing treatment at the Gleneagles Intan Medical Centre here since returning from Singapore yesterday, remains in stable condition today, an Istana Negara official said.

"The condition of His Majesty remains stable," Grand Chamberlain Datuk Zubir Ali said.

Sultan Salahuddin returned home yesterday after undergoing treatment for almost two months at the Mount Elizabeth Hospital in Singapore. The King underwent a minor surgery there on Oct 6.

A stream of royal visitors and VIPs called on Sultan Salahuddin at the hospital.

Apart from the Raja Permaisuri Agong Tuanku Siti Aishah who arrived at 10.35am, there was also a steady stream of VIPs.

Deputy Yang di-Pertuan Agong Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin, who is also the Acting Yang di-Pertuan Agong, and his wife Permaisuri Nur Zahirah also visited.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and wife Datuk Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali arrived at 9.40pm.

Earlier, Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Dr Mohd Khir Toyo and wife Datin Seri Zahrah Kechik arrived at 11.35am.

The Yang di-Pertuan Besar of Negri Sembilan Tuanku Ja'afar and Tuanku Ampuan Negri Sembilan Tuanku Najihah Tuanku Besar Burhanuddin arrived at 1pm.

The Regent of Selangor Tengku Idris Shah, who is the King's son, arrived at 3.15pm.
