Stop interfering, Pas tells DAP

KUALA LUMPUR: Pas yesterday told the DAP to stop interfering in its affairs, particularly on issues related to the concept of an Islamic State. Information chief Azizan Abdul Razak said Pas would decide what was best for the party and did not need to listen to DAP's views on what it should or should not do. He said DAP life adviser Dr Chen Man Hin should keep his views on Pas' Islamic State to himself. "What we have at hand involves Pas and (Prime Minister Datuk Seri) Dr Mahathir (Mohamad) as our plan is to submit a memorandum on the concept to the Prime Minister," he said.
