Stop questioning credibility of Attorney-General, says Rais

KUALA KLawang, Tues. - The opposition should cease questioning the credibility of Datuk Abdul Gani Patail in performing his duties as Attorney-General, said Minister in Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Dr Rais Yatim.

"There are parties who also question his personality and this is unfair. A person has to be judged by his performance in his field."

"Let Abdul Gani do his job and then we can judge his efficiency and his performance," said Rais at his Hari Raya open house at the Jelebu District Council Hall here today.

He was commenting on Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's statement on giving Abdul Gani a chance to prove himself.

"He has many responsibilities and he has to be given a chance to conduct himself before his performance can be judged."

Rais said the country had seven appointed Attorney-Generals since 1955 and problems of such nature never arose.

"The Prime Minister made his selection and if there are parties that still do not agree, then it is a different issue altogether."
