SULTAN OF JOHOR VISITS PUTRAJAYA

PUTRAJAYA, March 10 (Bernama) -- The Sultan of Johor Sultan Iskandar ibni Almarhum Sultan Ismail today visited the new federal government administrative centre here.

Sultan Iskandar, accompanied by the Sultanah of Johor and the royal entourage, was met on arrival by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and his wife, Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohamed Ali, at Laman Perdana in the Prime Minister's Department complex.

They were also greeted by Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Senator Datuk Abdul Hamid Zainal Abidin and Chief Secretary to the Government Tan Sri Samsudin Osman.

The royal couple and their entourage then proceeded to the sixth floor of the complex to observe the view.

They also visited the Prime Minister's office on the fifth floor.

Dr Mahathir later accompanied them to the Seri Perdana complex for lunch following which they made a tour of the area, ending at the Putrajaya Mosque.
