Task force to submit memo on annuity scheme to PM

IPOH, Fri. - The Save Annuity Task Force will submit a memorandum to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad urging him to reinstate the scheme for the benefit of Employees Provident Fund contributors.

Task force chairman Gunaraj George said it had embarked on a nationwide signature campaign to garner support from contributors.

It hopes to get 100,000 signatures during a week-long roadshow which started in Subang on Tuesday.

So far, 7,000 people including 500 who turned up for today's gathering at Syuen Hotel, have signed up.

The task force will be in Johor Baru tomorrow to continue with its campaign.

The EPF annuity scheme introduced in July last year, was suspended on May 10 pending a study by a consultant following objections from the Malaysian Trade Union Congress (MTUC).
