TIMBALAN YANG DI-PERTUAN AGONG ATTENDS CONFERENCE OF RULERS MEETING

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 8 (Bernama) -- The Timbalan Yang di-Pertuan Agong, the Sultan of Terengganu today attended the 190th meeting of the Conference of Rulers at Istana Negara here.

He was accompanied by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad. The meeting began yesterday, chaired by the Yang Dipertuan Besar of Negeri Sembilan.

All the Rulers except the Sultan of Kedah, the Sultan of Johor and the Sultan of Perak attended the meeting.

The Sultan of Kedah was represented by the Tunku Bendahara, Datuk Seri Tunku Annuar Ibni Almarhum Sultan Badlishah, the Sultan of Johor by the Tengku Mahkota, Tunku Ibrahim Ibni Sultan Iskandar and the Sultan of Perak by the Raja Muda, Raja Nazrin Shah Ibni Sultan Azlan Muhibbuddin Shah.

All the Yang Dipertuas Negeri attended the meeting.

Meanwhile, in a statement, the Keeper of the Rulers' Seal, Engku Datuk Ibrahim Engku Ngah said that among the matters discussed were national security and appointments.
