Ling-Meeting

WEDNESDAY'S HUAREN BOARD MEETING POSTPONED- DR LING

KOTA KINABALU, June 11 (Bernama) -- The meeting of Huaren Holdings Sdn Bhd Board of Trustees scheduled for Wednesday has been postponed, MCA President Datuk Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik said today.

This was because a member of the board, MCA vice president Datuk Chua Jui Meng, had stated that he would be unable to attend, he said.

"Datuk Chua Jui Meng has told me that he is not able to attend the meeting, so we will find a new date," he told reporters after opening the new Sabah Road Transport Department (JPJ) headquarters here.

Last week, Dr Ling announced that a meeting would be held on Wednesday, in response to a call made by Chua to discuss the issue of the buyover of Nanyang Press Holdings Bhd.

The board of trustees comprise Dr Ling, Chua, party deputy president Datuk Lim Ah Lek and secretary-general Datuk Seri Dr Ting Chew Peh.

On Dr Ting's call for an extraordinary general meeting, Dr Ling said that was just one of the various measures that could be taken under the party constitution.

"The move that has been taken by the party is to have the Presidential Council and Central Committee members vote in favour of the Nanyang deal," he said.

Dr Ling also said the MCA took seriously the call by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to MCA members to reconcile their differences.
