WISMA PUTRA SETS UP 24-HOUR OPERATION ROOM

SEPANG, Sept 11 (Bernama) -- The Foreign Ministry has set up a 24-hour operation room to monitor developments in the United States following terrorism attacks in New York and Washington, said its secretary general Datuk Ahmad Fuzi Abdul Razak.

He said Wisma Putra had directed its offices in New York, Washington and Canada to determine whether any Malaysian was involved.

"The information received will be relayed from time to time," he told reporters at the KL International Airport (KLIA) here last night.

He was at the KLIA to see off Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad who was supposed to leave for London for a brief visit to Britain.

Following the incident in the U.S., Dr Mahathir cancelled his trip.
