Zambry: Open criticisms will lead to downfall

UMNO is getting weak because some leaders and members "like to criticise the party openly for no obvious reason."

Umno Youth exco member Dr Zambry Abdul Kadir said party members should stick to the proverb "jangan buka pekung di dada" when dealing with internal problems.

"Internal problems should be solved in private and not openly.

"There should be a limit to just everything, even criticism hurled against the party. Open criticism will only lead to the party's downfall," he said when debating the motion of thanks to the address by party president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

Zambry added there were members who like to talk bad about Umno but did not make significant contributions.

"It is important for party leaders to overcome this problem once and for all as the movement is worried that such a behaviour, if not stopped, can lead to destruction from within."
