

PM celebrates with M'sians in London

LONDON: Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad celebrated Hari Raya Aidiladha yesterday with more than 900 Malaysians at the official residence of the Malaysian High Commissioner in Hampstead.

The Prime Minister and his wife, Datuk Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali, were popular with the crowd, made up mainly of students, who streamed in for the open house.

Dr Mahathir, who flew into Heathrow yesterday from Argentina, will have a busy week in London.

Today, he will address Malaysian students at The

Great Hall in Imperial College.

Tomorrow, he will hold talks with British Prime Minister Tony Blair at 10, Downing Street, and then cross over to the House of Lords where he will have an informal gathering, organised by the Baroness Uddin of Bethnal Green.

The next day, Dr Mahathir will attend a meeting of the Commonwealth Partnership on Technical Management after which he will have talks with the Ugandan President.

He ends his visit on Wednesday with a 'live' interview by Al-Jazeera Television.
