

Another world record for Malaysia

KUALA LUMPUR, Sun. — Malaysia today gained entry into the *Guinness Book of Records* with a feat of planting 110,461 trees in one minute on Oct 15, 2000.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today received a certificate to the effect from Malaysia Book of Records managing director Danny Ooi.

The presentation was made at

the launch of the National Landscape Day 2002 by Dr Mahathir at the Kuala Lumpur City Centre Esplanade today.

At the function, the Prime Minister also presented certificates and prizes to winners of the National Landscaping Competition 2001.

Johor took first honours in the nationwide tree-planting campaign category followed by Malacca and

Kuala Lumpur. In the district category, first prize went to Segamat district and runners-up was Sabak Bernam district.

SM Hulu Klang in Selangor walked away with first prize in the secondary school category followed by SMK Datuk Syed Omar (Kedah). In the primary school category, SK Sungai Pinang in Kelantan was champion.
