

Singapore DPM arrives tomorrow for three-day visit

KUALA LUMPUR, Sat. — Singapore's Deputy Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong will be in Malaysia for a three-day visit from Monday.

He will be accompanied by Members of Parliament Zainudin Nordin, Cedric Foo and Lim Hwee Hua, and officials from the republic's Foreign Affairs Ministry.

Lee will meet Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi, Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Syed Hamid Albar and Defence Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.

He is also expected to discuss and exchange views on enhancing bilateral relations as well as matters relating to regional political-economic developments, Wisma Putra said in a statement.

"The visit is seen in the context of consolidating and establishing rapport between leaders of both countries," the statement said.
