

King heads Kelantan

KOTA BARU, Fri. The Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Syed Sirajuddin Syed Putra Jamalullail heads the list of 344 recipients of awards in conjunction with the Sultan of Kelantan Sultan Ismail Petra's 52nd birthday tomorrow.

The King will be conferred the highest State award, the Darjah Kerabat Yang Amat Dihormati (DK), together with Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin of Terengganu and Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah of Selangor. The other recipient of the DK is Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

Rahman is the sole recipient of a State title, the Dato' Bentara Istana. Twenty-five recipients will be conferred awards which carry the title of Datuk.

Leading the list is Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Dr Rais Yatim, who will be awarded the Darjah Kebesaran Jiwa Mahkota Kelantan (SJMK).

The Darjah Kehebesaran Mahkota Kelantan (DPMK), which carries the title Datuk Paduka, will be awarded to Permodalan Nasional Berhad group chief executive Datuk Hamad Kama Piah Che Othman.

Other recipients are Deputy Ag-

riculture Minister Datuk Shariff Omar, the principal private secretary to the King of Thailand, M.L. Anuporn Kashemsant, and the Deputy Commissioner Thai Police Region 8, Police Maj Gen Manoch Kraiwong.

Malaysian Es-Servicemen Association president Senator Datuk Muhammad Abdul Ghani and Utama Banking Group chairman Nik Hashim Nik Yusoff are in the list of recipients of the Darjah Kebesaran Jiwa Mahkota Kelantan (DJMK), which also carries the title of Datuk Paduka.

Rashid Omar, Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia's Prof Dr Abdul Latiff Mohamad, Kelantan Education director Shafii Ismail and National Institute of Public Administration director Dr Zulkurnain Awang are among eight people conferred the Darjah Kebesaran Setia Mahkota Kelantan Yang Amat Terbilang (DPSK).

Four of hers are Museum and

Antiquity Department deputy director-general Datuk Dr Adi Taha, Kelantan Agriculture director Othman Ngah, State Federal Development Department director Ramli Abdul Rahman and Commander of Narathiwat Provincial Police, Police Maj Gen Jetnakorn Nabhitabhata.
