

No power struggle in Umno: Dr M

SHAH ALAM: Umno president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad dismissed speculation that there is a power struggle in the party.

He was commenting on a survey done by PAS organ *Harakah*.

On who is the most suitable leader to replace him, Mahathir said: "They (*Harakah*) did it on their own, why should we care."

The survey conducted by *Harakah* included Deputy Prime Minister and Umno deputy president Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi, Umno vice-presidents Datuk Seri Najib Abdul Razak and Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin and supreme council member Tengku Razaleigh Hamzah.

Top leader on the survey as of today is Najib with 1,085 votes, followed by Muhyiddin (1,326), Abdullah (962) and Razaleigh with 677 votes.
