## survey intended to cause split

PETALING JAYA: The survey by Internet news magazine *Harakah.com.my* on the most popular Umno leader was done by PAS in the hope of causing a split in the party, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

"That was the intention. That is what *Harakah* wants. It wants a crack to appear in Umno," Dr Mahathir told reporters after attending a charity golf tournament in aid of the Kubang Pasu community development foundation and the Kuala Langat Bestari Foundation at the Glenmarie Golf and Country Club yesterday.

On another issue, Dr Mahathir said both Malaysia and Singapore had an arrangement for Singaporeans to manage a lighthouse on Pulau Pisang, which is located near Pontian.

He said he did not know whether an intrusion really occurred as claimed in a report by a Malay daily yesterday.

"Pulau Pisang is owned by us but we have given Singapore a right of passage to man the lighthouse," he added.

The golf tournament raised a total of RM2.8mil, which will be used by the two foundations to finance the development of ICT education for poor schoolchildren.
