

# Search for Buniyamin over his porn claim

KOTA BAKAR: Kelantan police are looking for former PAS Member of Parliament for Bachok, Buniyamin Yaakob, to assist in investigations after reports were lodged against him for allegedly saying that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad had watched pornographic movies with his grandchildren.

Kelantan CID chief ACP Rahim Jani said a team of policemen went to two addresses purported to be Buniyamin's residences in Kelantan but could not locate him.

"We need to record Buniyamin's statement after recording statements from 18 persons, including a Utusan **Malaysia** reporter and an employee of a local television station," Rahim told reporters at a press conference here yesterday afternoon.

"We hope Buniyamin will

co-operate by turning up at state police headquarters. If he cannot be traced, police, as a last resort, will issue orders under Section 111 of the Criminal Procedure Code," he added.

Rahim said police had sought the co-operation of the Kedah and Kelantan PAS liaison offices to locate the 56-year-old fiery orator who works as a PAS information officer.

"We need to record statements from another four persons (besides Buniyamin) before submitting the case to the deputy public prosecutor," he added.

The investigations are the result of three police reports lodged in Kelantan, Terengganu and Kedah following Buniyamin's ceramah at Pusat Tarbiyah Islamiah Kelantan here on March 1.5, where he made the allegations against Dr Mahathir.
