

## PPP Youth:

# Make Kayveas full minister

KUALA LUMPUR: The Peoples' Progressive Party (PPP) Youth wing will table a resolution at its convention on Sunday urging Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to appoint party president Datuk M. Kayveas as a full Cabinet minister.

PPP Youth chief T. Murugiah said the party, as a component member of Barisan Nasional, should be given due recognition.

"We want our party to be accorded the same status as others. The leaders of the other parties are full ministers," he said yesterday.

Kayveas is the Deputy Housing and Local Government Minister.

Murugiah said Youth and Sports Minister Datuk Hishammuddin Hussein, who is also Barisan Youth chief, would officiate at the convention at Putra World Trade Centre.

Over 1,000 delegates from nine states are expected to attend.

He said the PPP supreme council had decided that Hishammuddin would officiate at the Youth convention and the Barisan Wanita chief at the Women's convention.

Murugiah said 45 resolutions would be tabled.

He said they would also pass a resolution urging the party's supreme council to make a representation to Dr Mahathir for eight Parliamentary seats and 16 state seats.
