

MIC to study new constituencies

KUALA LUMPUR, Fri. — MIC will study all proposed new constituencies under the electoral redelineation exercise before deciding on the percentage of new seats it wants to contest in the next general election.

Party president Datuk Seri S. Samy Vellu said that the study would look into the racial composition of each seat.

The party would discuss the study findings with Prime Minister and Barisan Nasional chairman Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.
