

'Set up unit to check allegations of phantom voters'

ALOR STAR, Fri. — The Kedah Barisan Nasional today proposed the setting up of a special unit under the Home Affairs Ministry to check on allegations of phantom voters.

The proposal was among 11 resolutions presented by Menteri Besar

and State BN chairman Datuk Seri Syed Razak Syed Zain to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad during a gathering in conjunction with the State BN convention yesterday.

The Kedah BN said the unit

should also liaise closely with the National Registration Department to stop the practise of imported or fictitious voters and maintain the integrity of the process and machinery of elections nationwide.
