MP's trial

postponed to next month

KOTA BARU: The defamation trial of the former PAS MP for Bachok, Buniyamin Yaakob, has been postponed to Dec 28 to Dec 31 after he complained of ill health.

Buniyamin, 56, was in the Sessions Court here yesterday morning on the first day of his trial when he complained of discomfort and nausea after two prosecution witnesses had testified.

Buniyamin, who is now a PAS information bureau officer, had allegedly uttered during a *ceramah* in March that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamed had watched pornographic videos with his grandchildren.

Police began investigations after two persons, one from Kedah, and the other from Kelantan, lodged reports.

Buniyamin, who appeared frail throughout his trial, had to be assisted when walking in and out of the court, presided by judge Azman Abdullah.
