AHMAD TAJUDIN REAPPOINTED YPEIM CHAIRMAN

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 8 (Bernama) -- Bank Islam Malaysia Bhd managing director Datuk Ahmad Tajudin Abdul Rahman has been reappointed as chairman of the Malaysian Islamic Economic Development Foundation (YPEIM) board of trustees.
