## Prai shock Pahang Telekom

UNFANCIED Seberang Prai Municipal Council pulled off a stunning upset in the MHF-Milo-Admiral-NSC Junior League when they edged title hopefuls Pahang Telekom 1-0 at the Kuantan Hockey Stadium yesterday.

Pahang's defeat has placed SMK Anderson within striking distance of the semi-finals as the Perak schoolboys beat MSS Kuala Lumpur 5-0 yesterday.

Seberang Prai took the opportunity to win three points off a half-strength Telekom side who did not have the services of nine regular players as eight had to play in the Pahang Schools Sports Council tournament while Ismail Abu was barred from playing because he reported late for national training.

But still, Pahang Telekom dominated the greater part of the match but their opponents showed plenty of resilience and strength to cut out the danger on numerous occasions.

Seberang Prai stunned the home side in one of their rare raids with K. Haarisan netting the winner with a brilliant field goal in the 24th minute after evading three defenders.

Pahang Telekom's defeat - their first in six matches - could be a costly one as they will now have to beat Group B leaders Serdang Hockey Club tomorrow to stay on course for a semifinal berth.

At the Azlan Shah Stadium, Anderson school played at half pace but won 5-0 against MSSKL. The result took them a step closer to the last four from Group B as they still have Terengganu Sports Council (MSST) and Telekom Pahang to play.

Anderson's top scorer Fazreen Eksan Wahab was in top form and knocked home the first three goals in the third, sixth and 10th minutes which took the fight out of the MSSKL players.

Mohamed Fahmi Baserah made it 4-0 in the 50th minute and defender Mohamed Shahidan Hassan took Anderson's tally to 5-0 in the 61st minute.

At the second pitch, cash-strapped Taiping District suffered another blow when SMK Dato Taha thrashed them 14-1 after leading 7-0 at half time.

Quamarul Hazimin Samad led the rout with four goals while the other scorers were Syed Mohamed Nadzmi, Immy Nur Ibrahim, Mohamed Anuar Hassan (two goals each); Ahmad Nazri Yatim, Aznizam Latif, Nurul Izwan Yatim and Muhamad Zulfarhan.

R. Viknesh scored the consolation for Taiping in the 46th minute.
